



## *Sermon Reflection Questions*

### **“Radical Betrayal and Radical Love” (John 13:18-38)**

October 10, 2021

How does Jesus’ reference to the “heel” in verse 18 (see also Gen 3:15, Psalm 41:7-9) help you better understand the big picture of the Bible? How does this help you to see the larger purpose of Christ and the cross in the plan of redemption?

How does Judas’ life mirror what you see in the world around you? In your own heart?

When you think about the word glorify being used 5 times in vs. 32-33, why is it hopeful to know that God can use even the darkest moments in our lives for His glory? Why is the cross the ultimate example of this?

When you think about all that Christ has done for you, why is it so important for us to remember that “the cross is the place where radical betrayal and radical love meet”? Why is this good news for those who trust Christ by faith?

How does cross propel us to live out the new commandment Christ gave in vs. 34-35? How does it challenge you to love your brothers and sisters in Christ in a better way? How does it challenge you to love those in the world around you? (school, work, those whom you are at odds with, etc)
